## **WORD ANALYSIS CHART**

Words can be dissected into their affixes, or word parts. The columned table below zeroes in on prefixes, suffixes, base words, and the two parts of a compound word. Increasing student awareness of how words are formed allows learners to transfer decoding skills to their reading. The chart below lists examples of words, with specific page numbers listed from the novel *The House on Mango Street*, by Sandra Cisneros. Primary-grade teachers need to focus on one affix, or part of speech, at a time, modeling extensively before requiring students to do this type of activity. Creating a classroom wall chart is also recommended.
